Tabu is the stand-out Italian ryegrass, bred for fast establishment and high yield over 1 to 3 years. Better yet, animals love it.

Multi-use

Use *Tabu* as a high performance winter crop, or a 2 - 3 year pasture in areas with mild summers. *Tabu* has explosive establishment speed, with exceptional winter and early spring growth.

Unbeaten yield

Tabu is still unbeaten in total yield in the latest National Forage Variety Trials® (NFVT), growing up to 16 t DM/ha over 12 months.

Top feed value

Tabu averages 12.3 ME in well-managed summer moist trials. Palatability is very good, so it's easy to graze.

High animal performance

In winter lamb finishing trials at Poukawa, lambs on *Tabu* grew at 316 g/day, with a stocking rate of 48 lambs/ha. On a per hectare basis, *Tabu* averaged 15.2 kg liveweight gain/day.

High yield hybrid.

Harper provides a high performance, 3 - 5 year pasture. It grows more DM in winter and early spring than perennial ryegrass.

Year-round grass

Harper establishes rapidly and provides excellent performance with exceptional growth in winter & spring, and good persistence.

Persistence

Trials show *Harper* has good persistence compared with other hybrids. Typically it will last for 3 - 5 years in summer moist environments; 2 - 3 years where summers are dry.

Palatable

Harper is highly palatable, for good animal performance and easier pasture management. It combines very well with red clover.

Compared to *Tabu*

Tabu will produce more DM than *Harper* over 12 - 18 months, but *Harper* is more persistent, and gives more growth over a 3 - 5 year period.

Bealey is a tetraploid perennial with high palatability. It is also very late heading with excellent late spring quality.

Loves clover

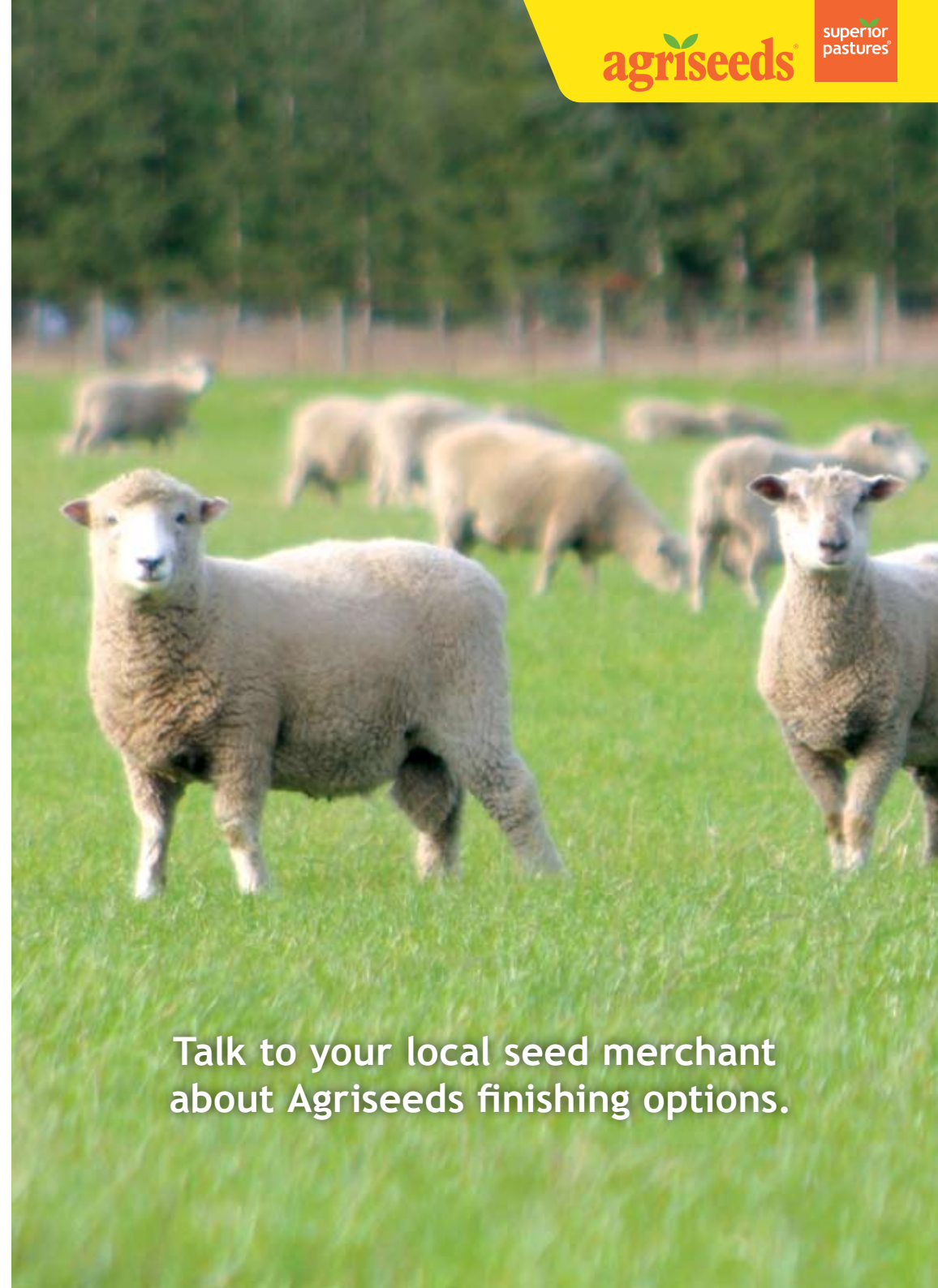
Bealey allows clover to flourish. Combined with strong year round growth, this creates a premium finishing pasture.

Long term persistence

Bealey has excellent persistence for a tetraploid perennial ryegrass. It also has *Plus NEA2* endophyte for added resistance to insects.

Management tip

Because it's so palatable, with a more open habit than diploid ryegrass, *Bealey* is more vulnerable to over-grazing than standard permanent pasture. To get the best out of it, avoid prolonged set stocking during dry conditions.

- Excellent persistence - improved drought & pest tolerance, including clover root weevil.
- High yielding, with improved performance in winter-spring & autumn.
- We recommend a 50:50 Apex & Weka mix, as they complement each other in a pasture.



Stronger. Tougher. Better.

High yielding medium-large leaved clover.

- Very high yielding, with good growth in all seasons, particularly in summer & autumn.
- High stolon growing point density, with a strong spreading habit & high tolerance to clover root weevil & dry conditions.



Red clover with staying power.

Improve summer quality & growth.

- Add 4kg/ha of Tuscan to any seed mix, to improve pasture growth & quality in summer & autumn.
- Persists best under less intensive stocking rates &/or extended summer grazing rotations.
