

## Annual ryegrass varieties

- Archie (T)** Tetraploid variety, with very fast establishment and high winter yield. Offers quality feed over a 6-8 month period, with excellent palatability. Ideal between maize, cereal or other summer crops. (Refer also to the *Archie* variety sheet on page 20).
- Devour** New Westerwold tetraploid annual ryegrass replacing *Apollo Gold*. *Devour* has an open erect growth habit.
- Progrow** Older diploid Westerwold variety, with fast establishment and good winter yield but poor persistence. Superseded by other varieties.
- SF Sultan** Diploid Westerwold variety with strong growth in autumn, winter and spring.
- Grasslands Tama (T)** Old tetraploid Westerwold variety released in 1968. Superseded by other varieties. Virtually no persistence.
- Winter Star II (T)** Tetraploid annual ryegrass with a medium heading date (+9 days). Suitable for quick winter feed production.
- Zoom (T)** Tetraploid Westerwold variety with late heading date (+16 days), dense tillering and good winter activity.

(T): Tetraploid varieties are best sown at 30% higher sowing rates because they have larger seeds.
