

Hybrid ryegrass varieties

Variety descriptions

Harper

High yielding ryegrass providing a medium-term pasture with a high total DM production and high palatability, suitable for all farming systems. *Harper* is fast to establish, and has good year-round growth, producing particularly well in the winter and early spring. It is late heading (+13 days) and is available *Without* endophyte and *Plus AR1*. (Refer also to the *Harper* sheet on page 15)

Delish (T)

Tetraploid variety with an intermediate heading date (+9 days) and low aftermath heading. Has good disease resistance and reasonable persistence in summer moist areas. Available with *AR1* or *Without* endophyte.

Maverick GII

Variety with better spring and summer yield than *Maverick Gold*. Does not contain endophyte.

SF Momentum

Densely tillered hybrid ryegrass with fine leaved tillers and good disease tolerance.

Storm (T)

European variety with less winter and spring growth than standard varieties.

(T): Tetraploid varieties are best sown at 30% higher sowing rates because they have larger seeds.
